Prescription Medicine under new Health Insurance:

As you may be aware there is a change to the way prescriptions are filled on our plan this year. We were recently notified that if you are on a monthly maintenance prescription that is not a controlled substance you will have to receive it via mail order. Once the prescription has been filled twice at the pharmacy the insurance requires that the prescription be filled via the OptumRx Mail Order program. This can be accomplished by calling the number on the back of your OptumRx Insurance card and speaking to the representative who will walk you through the process. When you go back to your doctor for your check-up you can advise him/her that you would like the prescription sent to the OptumRx Mail Order rather than your pharmacy and it will ease the transition. N.Y. State Amends Paid Voting Leave Law....

A revision to NY election law gives workers in the state up to three hours of paid time off to vote, Governor Cuomo highlighted in an announcement released on 04/01/19 about NY enacted budget for fiscal year 2020.

Under the new law, all employees may request up to 3 hours of paid time off to vote, regardless of their work schedules, as long as the request is made at least two working days prior to the election. The employer may designate that any requested time be taken at the beginning or the end of shift.

Next election is the primary June 25, 2019.
