#### **Burnwell Fire**

Mumford, NY- 9/13/11 The Mumford F.D. was dispatched to the Burnwell Gas Inc. facility on Main St. for a explosion with a fire at 15:03. The fire brought 4 alarms with 25 companies, over 100 firefighters from three counties and Rochester Airport foam truck. The Monroe County Fire Bureau's HazMat Team was also on scene and increased the Level 0, to 1, and finally at Level 2. The only employee from the building was transported to Strong Memorial Hospital with burns to his arms and face. The building,

two trucks, and a trailer were all a total loss in the fire as well as various size tanks. Wheatland Town Supervisor, Linda Dobson said "the plan was superb" and she was "very pleased" with the efforts of the fire department in controlling what could have been a much worse outcome. On 12/14/11 the parent company; Superior Plus Energy Services Inc. donated \$20,000 to Mumford Fire Dept. for their work during and continuing clean up. **Terry McGinnis** (Maintenance Supervisor) & **Johnnie Johnson** (HGPS) both volunteers of the Mumford Fire Dept. were on hand to assist.
