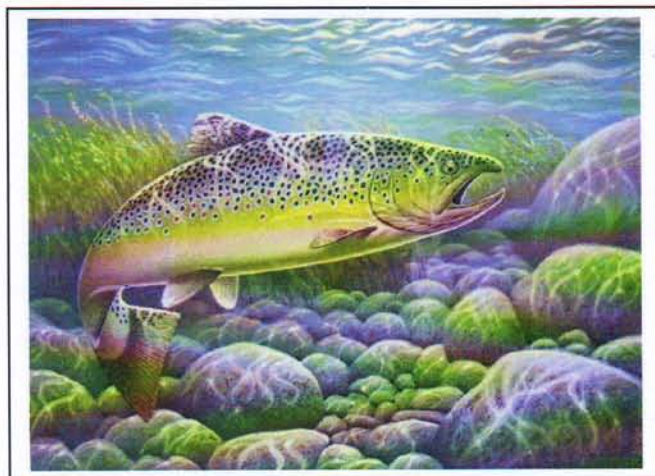
## SMC Scottsville

### The Oatka Creek

The word **O-AT-KA** is Native American and means "leaving the highlands" or "approaching an opening". The creek rises in the town of Gainesville and winds 58 miles through 3 counties, where it flows by **Sabin** and enters the Genesee River near Scottsville.

The Oatka Creek is stocked yearly by our local **Caledonia Fish Hatchery**. Over 4,000 Brown Trout varying in size from 8"-15" are stocked through the months of March to June. The Caledonia Fish Hatchery is open year long to the public and is the oldest fish hatchery in New York State as well as the nation.

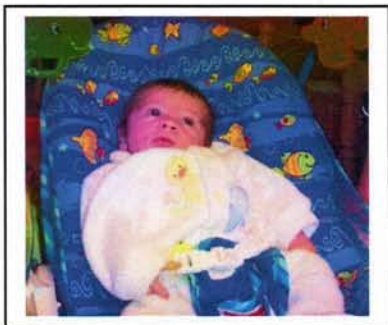


# Employees News
