## The History of Sabin Metal Corp. First of a 3 Part Series

#### {Excerpts take from essay by Andrew Sabin}

In the late 1800s Abraham Seratoff {grandfather of Andrew} immigrated to New York from the Sertov region of Russia. He had 5 children, one being Samuel {father of Andrew} born in 1909.

Abraham started a scrap business on the Lower East Side of New York City called "*A. Seratoff & Sons*". Samuel started working in the family business at age 12, leaving school with only a 6<sup>th</sup> grade education. Just prior to the stock market crash in 1929 Samuel accumulated \$500, which he turned into \$5,000. With this bit of luck he built a lead refinery in the early 1930's.

In 1943 Samuel entered into a partnership with a man named Ben. They combined their names (Sam & Ben) to form Saben Metal. In 1945, Andrew was born and Ben retired to Florida. Samuel tried to incorporate SABEN Metal, but found the name was already taken. He changed the "E" to an "I" and in late 1945 Sabin Metal was incorporated. Customers kept asking to speak with Mr. Sabin so in 1946 Samuel changed the family name to Sabin.

In the early years at the original headquarters on Lispenard Street in Manhattan Samuel focused on war surplus. He became an expert in stainless steel alloys, cadmium, nickel, tungsten & columbium. In 1957 Samuel helped to start the Dept. of Defense Precious Metal Recovery Program. Starting with silver recovery and eventually other precious metals. <u>End of Part One</u>
